With school out, Kirsty unwinds with a chapter of the book assigned by her literature teacher. She uses OneNote Class Notebook and voice typing to record her thoughts.



7:00 PM

After dinner, Kirsty logs on to Minecraft: Education Edition and starts working on a group project for her technology class. It's not due until next week, but she's keen to get ahead.
